**Sub.:** Review of Policy of 'No detention' upto elementary level - conduct of assessment and evaluation and improved implementation of Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE).

**Reference:** Government Order No. 866 Edu of 2018 dated 12/09/2018

Sir,

In the context of above subject and reference, it is submitted that the matter was discussed in detail in presence of Principal SIE Kashmir and Principals of the DIETs/ CEOs on 15-09-2018. In order to conduct T1 & T2 Examination of Class 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> (2018), there was consensus on the following Roadmap:


- 1) T1 and T2 Examinations, in respect of Class 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> shall be conducted by the respective schools with a common question paper to be prescribed by the respective DIET of the district as ordered vide above referred Government Order.
- 2) The question papers will be got printed confidentially by the Principal DIET, and will be kept under the custody of complex head (Z. Head) before the commencement of the examination through DIET concerned. The complex head will ensure that strong room is notified in advance in order to ensure the safety of the printed material.
- 3) The school wise confidential material (question papers) available with complex head in respect of a particular subject shall be issued one hour before the commencement of the timing in favour of the superintendent after proper receipt.
- 4) In order to ensure proper monitoring and supervision, the supervisory staff, including superintendent shall be appointed and notified by the concerned DIETs in consultation with CEO/ ZEO concerned well in advance.
- 5) For maintaining transparency, the supervisory staff shall be exchanged among the nearby schools falling within a particular complex head.

- 6) The Principal/ Headmaster, as will <sup>be</sup> notified by the concerned DIETs in consultation with CEO and ZEO shall be inspector for overall supervision and for smooth conduct of the examination within his/ her jurisdiction.
- 7) Every superintendent will ensure that the answer books are properly deposited in complex head on the same date within 02 hours after the completion of the paper.
- 8) The evaluation of the answer books shall be done at complex level through a team of evaluators to be appointed and notified by the concerned Principal DIET in consultation with CEO/ ZEO concerned.
- 9) The result shall be compiled at district level by the DIETs and also declared uniformly.

Further, in addition to the above for the ensuing T2 examination, a scheme has been devised in consultation with Principal DIETs by Principal SIE, Kashmir (Copy enclosed).

The above roadmap may kindly be notified at the earliest keeping in view the fact that limited time is left for conducting of the T2 examination.


